








Lightning Round of Assessment Tools

	<p>What? <i>Blackboard Test</i> features and settings help minimize cheating</p> <p>Where? Built into Blackboard: Course Tools>Tests, Surveys, and Pools>Tests</p> <p>How? http://edtech.mst.edu/support/blackboard9-1/createdeploytest/</p> <p>Who? Presenter -Barb Wilkins</p>
	<p>What? <i>Respondus</i> gives automatic student feedback, saves time in test creation, converts Word documents into Blackboard testing format.</p> <p>Where? Campus site license - contact HelpDesk to have it installed on your office computer.</p> <p>How? http://edtech.mst.edu/support/respondus/</p> <p>Who? Presenter – Dr. David Westenberg</p>
	<p>What? <i>Diploma</i> is a test and question generation tool that randomizes questions, minimizes cheating in online assessments, saves time in creating unique tests for each student, grades multiple test versions easily.</p> <p>Where? Campus site license - contact HelpDesk to have it installed on your office computer.</p> <p>How? http://edtech.mst.edu/support/diploma/</p> <p>Who? Presenter –Dr. Jeff Thomas</p>
	<p>What? TurningKey uses clickers to answer paper-based assessments. May be used with multiple test versions, instant student feedback, students work at own pace, instructor only needs to create an answer key-easier and quicker than TurningPoint slides...good first step for clickers.</p> <p>Where? Installed on classroom machine by IT or “no install version” may be on a flash drive.</p> <p>How? http://edtech.mst.edu/support/turningtech/turningkey/</p> <p>Who? Presenter – Dr. Nancy Stone</p>
	<p>What? Rubrics making subjective assignments easier to grade objectively; helping students know the expectations of their work – often used to assess higher levels of thinking.</p> <p>Where? May attach your own rubric or integrate into Blackboard assignments or assessments.</p> <p>How? http://edtech.mst.edu/events/presentations/</p> <p>Who? Presenter – Dr. Katie Shannon</p>
